

A Message from the CUSF

Welcome to the Canadian University Shooting Federation (CUSF) Silvercore Handgun Challenge!

CUSF rules and print-out targets will be used for this challenge and will feature simple rules and will be easily accessible to any CUSF student members. All participants in this challenge <u>MUST</u> have a CUSF membership. The Grand Prize for this challenge is provided by Silvercore and other prizes will be provided through financial support from the Cabela's Outdoors Fund. The challenge will be open to all Canadian students who have a CUSF membership and will run from February to March 2022.

CUSF's mission statement is Learn, Compete, Educate. Providing an opportunity for students to participate in this handgun challenge will introduce shooting sports in a safe, fun, affordable, accessible, and competitive way.

Getting Started

- 1. Entry is FREE for CUSF student members. Each student member is allowed one entry.
- 2. All students who submit a score will be entered into a random draw to win a <u>grand</u> <u>prize</u> or other smaller prizes!
- 3. Go to shop.CUSF.ca and purchase a CUSF student membership if you don't have a 2021 membership.
- 4. Go to the programs section of our website and sign up for our CUSF-Silvercore Handgun Challenge https://cusf.ca/event-registration/.
- 5. Print targets found on the Event Resources page https://cusf.ca/rules-and-scoresheets/
- 6. Shoot your target at an appropriate location. If you are the executive of a club, you should organize a day or two at a local range to get your members out to participate.
- 7. Score your target. If you need help contact matthew.kane@cusf.ca.
- 8. Submit your targets online. Email scans or photos of the targets to submitmyscore@CUSF.ca
- 9. See your score online on the CUSF website.
- 10. Take photos! Everyone is encouraged to share their experience on social media.
- 11. Don't forget to tag the CUSF. If you have pictures that you would like to share with the CUSF, follow the instructions under Photo Submissions.

All You Need to Participate!

- 1. Safety glasses and ear protection;
- 2. A handgun and appropriate ammunition;
- 3. A printer;
- 4. A 20m (or 10m if 20m not accessible) range with suitable backstop.

Rules:

1. All participants must have a valid 2021 CUSF student membership.







- 2. The CUSF-Silvercore Handgun Challenge will run from February 15th to March 31st. Scores are due by 11:59pm on March 31st.
- 3. Scores must be submitted to submitmyscore@CUSF.ca by 11:59 pm on the last day of each month. Targets must be legible and in good enough condition to be read by CUSF staff to verify the score.
- 4. Targets will be scored by the participant or witness if available. The total number of points available is 360. For the non dominant hand shots, the points are worth triple, for the shots from 20m, the points are worth double. Where a projectile has cleanly broken a line on the target, the higher score will be used. V-bulls are worth 10 points and will be used for tie breakers.

Tie Breaker: If there is a tie for one of the top 3 places, the most X bull hits for all targets will win. If multiple participants are still tied after this, the most timed-stage X bull hits will be

used. If multiple participants are still tied after this, one-hand dominant X bull hits will be used. If participants are still tied after this, the 1st slow-deliberate shooting with two hands group X bull hits will be used. If there is still a tie after that, winners will be chosen by having names drawn from a hat.

- 5. Any legal handgun may be used. There are no restrictions on type or calibre.
- 6. Standard factory rimfire or centerfire ammunition is allowed.
- 7. Only iron sights are permitted. Optics are not permitted.
- 8. Course of Fire:
 - 1. Slow deliberate shooting with two hands 5 shots No time limit
 - 2. One-handed, dominant hand 3 shots- No time limit
 - 3. One-handed, non-dominant hand 3 shots (points worth triple) No time limit
 - 4. Shoot two, reload, shoot two 4 shots No time limit
 - 5. 5 shots in 15 seconds 5 shots
 - 6. Slow deliberate shooting with two hands from 20m 5 shots- No time limit (points worth double)







- ** All shots will be taken from 10m, except for the last set of 5 shots, which will be taken at 20m.
- ** If using a revolver, for stage 4; the shooter will shoot two, reload 2 chambers, shoot two.
- 9. Time Limit: Stage 5 has a time limit as described. Otherwise time is unlimited.
- 10. One set of printed targets per participant will be allowed. Targets are to be printed on standard 8.5"x11" paper and pinned on card paper, cardboard, or any other surface that will allow bullets to cut cleanly through the target. All information must be on the targets for scores to qualify.
- 11. The target must be placed as follows:
 - Stages 1-5: 10 metres between the shooter's feet and the target
 - Stage 6: 20 metres between the shooter's feet and the target. If your range does not permit shooting from 20m, use the target provided that is 50% smaller, placed at 10m.
- 12. Acceptable Equipment is as follows: The handgun is legal to use. Eye and ear protection are MANDATORY. All shots must be taken freehand and no equipment is allowed for additional support (braces etc). Holsters are not required. If a participant decides to use a holster they should have been trained in its use.

Prizes and awards

The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners of the 2021 CUSF-Silvercore Handgun Challenge will receive a medal. At least one member from each club that enters will be guaranteed a prize.







So I didn't win... now what? Every CUSF member who participates in the 2021 CUSF-Silvercore Handgun Challenge will be entered into a draw for a prize. One winner will be drawn for each club that participates. Each registration gives you 1 chance to win a prize for your club draw. Odds of winning will be based on participation.

The <u>Grand Prize</u> is a **250\$ gift card to Silvercore products (in-person and online) + a free Silvercore Club membership for 1 year!!** (Must have valid PAL/RPAL to win).

All students who participate in the handgun challenge will be eligible for the grand prize draw with 1 entry each. Odds of winning will be based on participation.

<u>Prizes will be shipped in April 2022:</u> Those who have won placed prizes or raffle prizes will have their respective prizes mailed or e-mailed to them.
